

Case 2

- Ma. Rehan Ansari, 20yr/ M
- Apr 1994 headache, vomiting since 2yrs progressive deterioration of vision since 1 month RE – FC 6 ft, LE – no PL
- CT scan 25.04.1994 cystic densely calcified suprasellar lesion
- Sx 10.05.1994 Lt frontal craniotomy with subtotal excision (tumour in proximity to pitutary stalk was left behind)
- HPR craniopharyngioma
- RT 5040cGy/ 28# with B/L portals till 22.09.94
- VP shunting done in V/O headache & vomiting




Pre op CT 25.04.1994



- On regular follow up without vision improvement till 1997, then lost to follow up.
- 2005 h/o ? GTC. Started on Tab Eptoin
- May 06 headache & further deterioration of vision
- MRI & CT 01.05.2006 recurrence of lesion with calcification causing compression of optic chiasma & mild hydrochephalous.
- Steriotactic aspiration of cyst twice trasiently better
- Sx 24.08.2006 Excision of rec cranioph
- Intraop calcification adherent to It optic nerve & ACA complex

- No improvement in vision, developed DI which responded to vasopressin
- No added neurodeficit









